WINEMAKER NOTES

Each grape cluster for our 2013 pinot noir was hand picked from our vineyards. The grapes are then destemmed and then pushed down by hand for 14 days.

Our 2013 pinot noir marries the richness of the new world and the delicateness of the old world. It leads with nice oak aroma well combined with black cherry and cassis on the nose. It's followed by black cherry on the front palate, black currants on the mid to back palate and finishes with a touch of smokiness from the integration of the oak.
